Join Cardinal Mahony and JFI to Celebrate a Mass in Support of Immigrants

On March 21, the Justice for Immigrants (JFI) campaign will host a Mass in support of immigrants at 11:00am at St. Aloysius Church (19 I Street N.W., Washington DC 20001). Cardinal Mahony and Bishop Wester will be our celebrants and we expect to have numerous bishops, pastors and Catholic leaders from across the U.S. in attendance.

Immediately following the Mass, many of us will be joining with hundreds of organizations and thousands of people in the “March for America: Change Takes Courage and Faith”. This event will take place on the National Mall and begins with an Interfaith Prayer Service at 1:00pm that leads into the Rally and the March at 2:00pm. Participants will also have the opportunity to lobby for immigration reform on Capitol Hill the following day. We cordially invite and encourage everyone to attend these momentous events in support of fair and humane immigration reform.
